

## Camp Butano Creek General Equipment & Clothing List

It is best to limit luggage to two pieces: one sleeping bag and one duffel bag, as your camper will need to be able to carry it to and from her unit. She may also pack items in a daypack/backpack. Please do not send your camper with hard sided suitcases. **LABEL EVERYTHING WITH CAMPER'S NAME.** Pack one complete outfit for each day, the camp does not have laundry facilities.

<p><b><u>EQUIPMENT NEEDED:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Warm sleeping bag</li> <li>• 1—2 warm blankets</li> <li>• Unbreakable cup with handle</li> <li>• Flashlight, plus extra batteries</li> <li>• Water bottle or canteen</li> <li>• Daypack</li> </ul> <p><b><u>CLOTHES:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1 Swimsuit (<u>Wavecatchers need 2</u>)</li> <li>• 2-3 Shorts / Capri's</li> <li>• 4-6 Long Pants / Jeans</li> <li>• 7 Short Sleeve Shirts or Tank Tops with 2" wide straps</li> <li>• 4+ Long Sleeve Shirts</li> <li>• 7—9 pairs Underwear (<u>Wavecatchers need 10</u>)</li> <li>• 7—9 pairs Crew Socks (or longer length)</li> <li>• 2 pairs warm PJ's or sweat suit (to sleep in)</li> <li>• 2 Sweatshirts or Sweaters (<u>Wavecatchers need 3</u>)</li> <li>• Baseball cap or hat with brim</li> <li>• Warm hat; Gloves or Mittens</li> <li>• Warm Jacket</li> <li>• Raincoat / Rain Poncho with hood</li> <li>• 2 pairs shoes with good tread; Sneakers or Hiking Boots - <b>NO SANDALS</b></li> <li>• Water Shoes (<u>Wavecatchers need for walking to beach</u>)</li> <li>• Laundry Bag</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>PERSONAL ITEMS:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Toothbrush and toothpaste</li> <li>• Shampoo / Conditioner</li> <li>• Bath Soap</li> <li>• Hairbrush and comb</li> <li>• Sunscreen (spf 15 or higher)</li> <li>• Lip balm with sunscreen</li> <li>• Insect repellent (NO AEROSOL)</li> <li>• Deodorant</li> <li>• 2 bath towels, 1 washcloth, 1 hand towel</li> <li>• Beach towel (<u>Wavecatchers need 2</u>)</li> <li>• Bag / Container to carry shower items</li> <li>• Kleenex</li> <li>• Menstruation Supplies (if necessary)</li> <li>• Medication, if needed</li> <li>• Bandana(s)</li> <li>• Hair ties / Scrunchies / Hair Bands</li> <li>• Stationary, pens, pencils, &amp; stamps</li> </ul> <p><b><u>OPTIONAL (but nice to have):</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Camera and film (try disposable)</li> <li>• Sunglasses with head strap</li> <li>• Pillow and pillowcase</li> <li>• Twin fitted bed sheet— to cover camp mattress</li> <li>• Favorite stuffed animal</li> <li>• Rubber shoes—<u>for shower only</u></li> <li>• Extra pair of shoes</li> </ul> <div style="border: 1px dashed black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p><b><u>Wavecatchers:</u></b> Need to have clean underwear, bra, socks, top and sweats along with dry shoes to wear back to camp, after each surf lesson.</p> </div>

**Do not bring:** no-show socks; halter, backless, or spaghetti strap tops; toeless / backless shoes, sandals; aerosol cans, glass bottles; **cellular phones / pagers;** expensive cameras; any electronic devices; rings or other valuable jewelry; footlockers. Campers should also **NOT bring:** candy, gum, or snacks with them to camp.

**Helpful advice:** When packing for camp, think of your camper, if she tends to be cold pack extra warm things. Pack enough shirts, socks, and underwear so your child has enough for each day and an extra. It is best to bundle outfits together for each individual day, so it is easier for her to get ready in the morning. You can even put a set of clothes (pants, shirt, socks and underwear) in a gallon-sized zip-lock bag and labeled as "shorts & t-shirt" or "long sleeved / long pants". It is best to put all bottles containing liquid (shampoo, liquid soap, sunscreen) in plastic bags for traveling. While at camp it is easier if your camper has something to carry her bathroom supplies in; mesh bags work well. Attach a packing list inside your camper's bag to help her pack at the end of the session. For younger campers pre-address and stamp envelopes for letters. Have your camper pack her bags with you.
